One year ago, we met at the ZAD near Nantes for the Transborder Summer Camp: more than 500 activists came together for amazing exchange and mutual inspiration. Now, we want to invite you for a *digital*TSC in the days/evenings from the 15th to 18th of July.

With the *digitaI*TSC we want to provide a space to re-discuss strategies and challenges in (post) Corona times: we want to continue the discussions and networking debates that took place at the TSC, to understand where we are now 1 year later. And importantly, we want to propose a transnational decentralized mobilization for the beginning of September: on the 5th anniversary of the "March of Hope" – and the historic breakthrough against the border regime in 2015 during the long summer of migration along the Balkan route.

The *digital*TSC will take place in different online meetings. Below you find a first program.
